

## Important Reminder

Campers are required to provide their own self-care. If they need assistance with self-care they must bring a caregiver with them.

Campers are allowed to bring a sighted companion if they desire. Campers must be their own legal guardian, and able to make their own medical decisions. If a camper has a legal guardian that guardian must accompany the camper.

During the summer program a nurse is either on site or readily available 24 hours a day. The nurse is available to assist with blood pressure and blood sugar monitoring, and other minor concerns.

persons with visual impairment and blindness.



Over 800 campers during the summer months enjoy weekly overnight stays with numerous recreational and entertaining activities. The visually impaired persons enjoy fun and relaxation while developing friendships with each other, staff and volunteers.



# The Summer Destination for the Visually Impaired and Blind



Camp Dogwood has developed over the years from a rustic camp setting into a beautiful campus retreat center. The guest rooms have two full size beds, temperature controls and a private bath. Each dormitory houses a screened porch with rocking chairs and a lounge equipped with TV and a kitchenette. The grounds have paved walkways and driveways for easy mobility.

The Lodge features a touchable art gallery and library. The library includes a computer/media center, audio, braille material and CCTV's.

The campus includes a sensory garden and nature trail complete with guide roping. The dormitories and lodge are equipped with free wi-fi internet access.

The summer recreational program begins the first week of June with sessions lasting into August. This program is designed for adults ages 18-100+ years. Each week long session begins on Sunday afternoon and ends the following Saturday morning.

The many recreational experiences include boating, tubing, swimming, fishing, art classes, crafts seminars, exercise classes, shopping trips, bowling trips, on-site miniature golf, bingo games, dances, educational seminars and much more.



The well equipped kitchen and dining room furnish wholesome and satisfying meals each day.

## Utmost Professional Care

The camp program staff experience a comprehensive week of training prior to camper's arrivals. This training includes but is not limited to CPR, first aid, AED defibrillator, blind sensitivity, blind mobility, sighted guide techniques and fire safety.
