Lion KidSight Program

Lion Dave presented a KidSight screening overview and training session during the Club’s 10/18. We already have several Lions trained on the KidSight screening with our Pusoptix S12. On Thursday, 10/21, John Wiley and Dave Shimberg screened of 21 kindergarteners at the Lakeside Charter Academy in Huntersville. 18 children passed and 3 were referred to eye care professionals.



On Tuesday, 10/26, Lion Dave helped the Mooresville Lions Club screen nearly 600 children at Mooresville Intermediate School. Lion Dave screened 95 children, referring 17 for follow-up with eye doctors.
