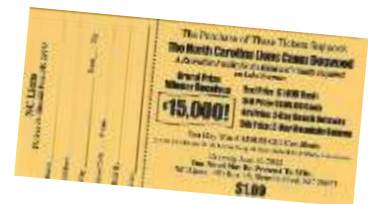


Sell Camp Dogwood Tickets, Don’t Just buy 3
