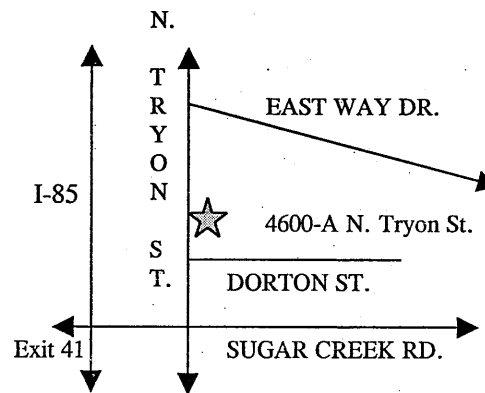

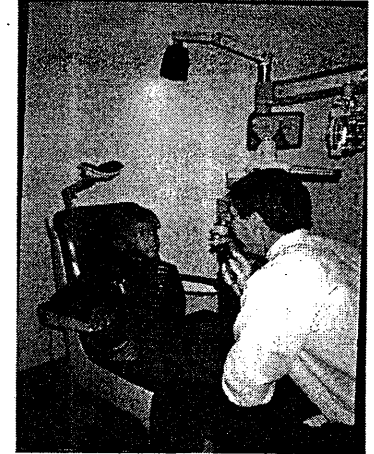

Persons with limited income or without insurance often cannot afford quality eye health care. With access to affordable, eye care and prescription eyeglasses, children function better in school, adults perform jobs better and seniors retain personal independence and enhanced quality of life.

Heritage

The Charlotte Central Lions Club established the Agency in 1935 as the Charlotte Workshop for the Blind. In 1975, the Agency was incorporated as a nonprofit textile manufacturer, privately owned by the Lions Clubs of Mecklenburg County to employ people who are blind and became known as Lions Services, Inc. (LSI). In 1997, LSI opened the Lions Services Eye Clinic to provide eye health care to those whom cannot afford this necessity.

Mission

Provide vocational rehabilitation and employment opportunities to individuals who are blind or visually impaired and to provide eye care for those within our community who need financial assistance. We intend to provide these individuals with life long opportunities and choices that promote personal and economic independence for an enhanced quality of life, while respecting their dignity and right of self-determination.

Who is eligible for service?

Any person who:

- Is referred by Mecklenburg County Schools, NC Department of Health and Human Services, Lions Clubs, churches or other organizations.
- Is uninsured or uninsurable
- Receives Medicaid
- Qualifies for low income status



What services are available?

- Complete eye examinations, including dilation for detections of eye diseases
- Prescription eye glasses
- Professional eye health counseling

Patients may choose from a variety of frames, which are fitted for appearance and comfort.



Staff

Local Ophthalmologists donate their valuable time and skills to assist the Eye Clinic Opticians with providing thorough examinations and prescriptions for glasses.
